Junior Roadwatch

Year 5 had an amazing opportunity to partake in a Junior Road Watch with the metropolitan police. Junior Roadwatch is a collaborative program between the council's Road Safety team and the Metropolitan Police, aimed at educating drivers about the risks of speeding near schools.

This included small groups of students working alongside police officers, using speed guns to identify vehicles exceeding the speed limit.



The day started with a Q&A where the children learnt about the rules around speeding on the road and the consequences of speeding. They then had the opportunity to go into the police van and the motorbike.





The children then had the opportunity to use the speed guns outside to check the speed of the cars passing by the school. They also had specific questions for the drivers that were speeding.
