NHS Wellbeing Project

A big thank you to the ladies in our community who helped us put together a 5 week Wellbeing project together with psychologists from the NHS. We have already sent out a letter inviting all the mums, aunts, older sisters, grandmas and carers to come and join us for some snacks, fun, laughter and reflections! There is no need to book - just turn up and learn more about yourself. Read below for reminders about the details - there are posters in our classrooms too!

Come and meet other mums in a safe space with tea, coffee and biscuits on Tuesday mornings (except one which will be on Tuesday afternoon). You told us you wanted a space to meet other mums, get creative and talk about your wellbeing.

Psychologists from Redbridge NHS will be running 'beads of life' sessions to support the wellbeing of mum's at Fullwood Primary School. Beads of Life uses beads to share stories about our life and the things we are good at. The beads will be used to create keyrings or bracelets that you can take away as a symbol of your time with the group.

We welcome you to join one or as many of the sessions you can. You will get the most out of the sessions if you attend all of them, but we understand that is not always possible. We know some of you may not be able to attend due to Ramadan and so we hope to return next term (summer) to offer more sessions.

We are delighted to inform you that the Scholastic Book Fair is returning just in time for World Book Day. Children received their World Book Day voucher today so they can get £1 off a book!



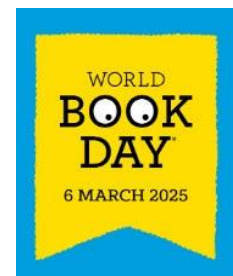

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.
Attendance percentages can be misleading.

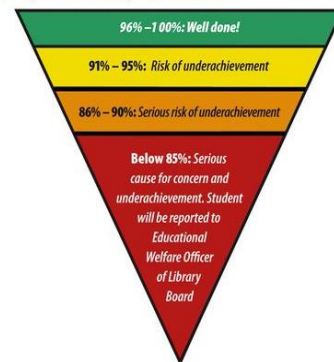
For some parents 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly four school weeks.

Attendance Star' Class

Remember to ensure your child is at school every day and that he/she is in school ready for our soft start from 8.50 am - 9.00 am at the latest. This is time for your child to review their work in books, respond to their teacher's marking and to read and complete early work activities.

The class with the best attendance each week will get the star which will be displayed in the main school hall. The class with the most attendance stars at the end of the year will receive a surprise fun trip as a reward for excellent attendance.
